CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Currently, 509 firefighters remain on-scene with additional resources available should further need arise. Firefighters continue to perform spot checks throughout the burned areas to prevent any chance of rekindle with a change in the weather. Current objectives include looking for further opportunities to build containment lines. We continue to monitor the weather and a Red Flag Warning will be in affect from this evening through Monday afternoon. Wind prone areas will see gusts between 40-50mph with sustained winds between 10-25mph.
