<b>Current Situation:</b>	<p>For tonight, north to northeast winds will develop once again. The winds tonight will be a bit stronger with gusts between 20 and 30 MPH. The stronger offshore winds will keep relative humidity lower, especially across the ridges and upper slopes. Firefighting resources will continue to mop up and patrol. Crews remain diligent in providing public service to residents as they return to their homes. Structures destroyed and damaged have been validated by damage assessment teams.
